

**GPLHS AUXILIARY MEETING

A motion was made to give the student council \$100.00 to reimburse them for part of the money that was spent on candy. Motion carried.

It was also mentioned that the school needs a ball rebounder. It was suggested that we give the offerings of today toward purchase of a ball rebounder. We were informed that the funds for the rebounder would probably be donated.

Pastor Geiger met with the auxiliary. He informed us that the ornament fund is replacing the Christmas card fund. He also informed us about some of the programs that Kingdom Workers are working on. They are working on support groups for the sexually abused. They also have support systems for babysitters for foster parents because the babysitters in these cases must be 18 years or older. They also have training in Milwaukee for Builders for Christ.

Pastor Geiger closed with a prayer.

The sophomore class served the meal of tator-tot hotdish, salad and bars.

Motion was adjourned at 11:45 am.
